

HARLEY DAVIDSON TERMS & CONDITIONS

YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES

If you sign this Deed, you are taking on several responsibilities, including:

- to pay Harley-Davidson or its Affiliates up to \$1,000 towards the costs of repairing or replacing any Motorcycle which is damaged, lost or stolen as a result of any incident due to your negligence, recklessness, intentional misconduct or breach of this Deed; and
- to reimburse Harley-Davidson and its Affiliates for all their expenses relating to:
 - any Claim you or your Heirs make against them when you have agreed not make such a Claim;
 - any Claim made against them to the extent that it relates to your negligent or reckless Use or intentional misuse of a Motorcycle; or
 - the seizure of a Motorcycle in your possession, custody or control as a result of your negligence, recklessness, intentional misconduct or breach of this Deed.

USER RULES

The following rules apply to all Motorcycle Users, including passengers

- A. At all times while Using Motorcycles, Users must wear:
- (a) a properly fitted approved motorcycle helmet (complying with Australian/New Zealand Standard AS/NZS 1698:2006);
 - (b) appropriate protective eyewear;
 - (c) a jacket specifically designed for motorcycle riding;
 - (d) fully enclosed, sturdy gloves specifically designed for motorcycle riding;
 - (e) sturdy long pants; and
 - (f) sturdy, fully-enclosed footwear.
- B. Motorcycles may only be Used by people who have signed the Motorcycle User Deed and User Eligibility Declaration, and Users must not allow anyone else to Use any Motorcycle in their possession, custody or control.
- C. Users who participate in a group ride organized by Harley-Davidson or its Affiliates must comply with their directions and instructions.
- D. Users must co-operate with any investigation into an accident or incident which occurs when a Motorcycle is in their possession, custody or control.
- E. Users must not be under the influence of alcohol, drugs or any substance known to impair driving ability or have a blood alcohol content that exceeds the legal limit in the relevant State or Territory while Using any Motorcycle.
- F. All Use of Motorcycles by Users must reflect favourably on Harley-Davidson and its Affiliates and must not in any way disparage or bring them into disrepute.

The following additional rules apply to Users who operate Motorcycles

- G. Users must obey all traffic laws while Using the Motorcycle including, without limitation, not speeding or engaging in careless, negligent or reckless driving, and must Use the Motorcycle in a safe manner at all times.
- H. Users must immediately report any accident or spill involving any Motorcycle in their possession, custody or control to a Harley-Davidson representative in person or by telephoning +61 2 9886 0600, and must also promptly report the incident in writing to the Promotions Executive, Harley-Davidson Australia Pty Ltd, 1 Sirius Road, Lane Cove NSW 2066 (facsimile +61 2 9886 0699).
- I. Users must promptly provide copies of any traffic or parking infringement notices issued by any law enforcement agency in relation to any Motorcycle in their possession, custody or control to the Promotions Executive, Harley-Davidson Australia Pty Ltd, 1 Sirius Road, Lane Cove NSW 2066 (facsimile +61 2 9886 0699).
- J. Users must pay any fines levied against them for traffic or parking infringements in relation to any Motorcycles in their possession, custody or control.
- K. Users must maximise the security of Motorcycles while they are in their possession, custody or control, and must follow all reasonable directions given by Harley-Davidson or its Affiliates in relation to security.

L. Users must not carry pillion passengers, except with the express permission of Harley-Davidson or its Affiliates. All passengers must complete and sign a Motorcycle User Deed and a User Eligibility Declaration.
